

A Letter from the Board Announcing Editorial Transition



It was with sadness and deep gratitude that the Editorial Board of *Reflective Practice* at its December 6, 2013 meeting accepted the wish of Herbert Anderson to retire as of Volume 34 as the editor of the journal he has so skillfully edited. Herbert has been significantly connected to the Journal (formerly *The Journal of Supervision and Training in Ministry*) since 1985. He agreed to become the editor in 2006 if: a) the location of the journal could move to the Bay Area; and b) the name of the journal could be changed—*Reflective Practice: Formation and Supervision in Ministry* was born. The eight volumes of *Reflective Practice* produced under Herbert's editorship have exceeded all expectations and been universally recognized. Because he has not moved far away (Sonoma, California), Herbert has promised to stay connected to the journal.

On February 2, 2014, the Editorial Board confirmed R. Scott Sullender as the new editor. Scott has been on the Editorial Board of *Reflective Practice* since its inception in 2006. He is well-known in the field of pastoral care and counseling and currently serves as Professor of Pastoral Counseling at San Francisco Theological Seminary in San Anselmo. Scott is a Diplomat in the American Association of Pastoral Counselors. His most recent book is *Ancient Sins...Modern Addictions: A Fresh Look at the Seven Deadly Sins*. Scott is already at work on Volume 35. The Editorial Board looks forward to Scott's leadership as Editor.
