**Brenda Perry Wallace, *Clinical Pastoral Education: A Survival Kit*
(San Bernardino, CA: Self-published, 2017), 243 pp.**

This self-published overview of the curricular elements of CPE training was inspired by the author's qualitative dissertation research and her own experiences as a certified educator. Much of the book covers general pedagogical aspects of CPE, with some mention of themes derived from research on students' experiences in a one-unit CPE program conducted in the West Indies. Although the themes listed are quite compelling, they are mentioned only briefly. As a self-published book, there were inconsistencies in style and formatting. Nonetheless, audiences curious about or contemplating CPE might benefit from this peek inside the process of CPE.
